Who We Are

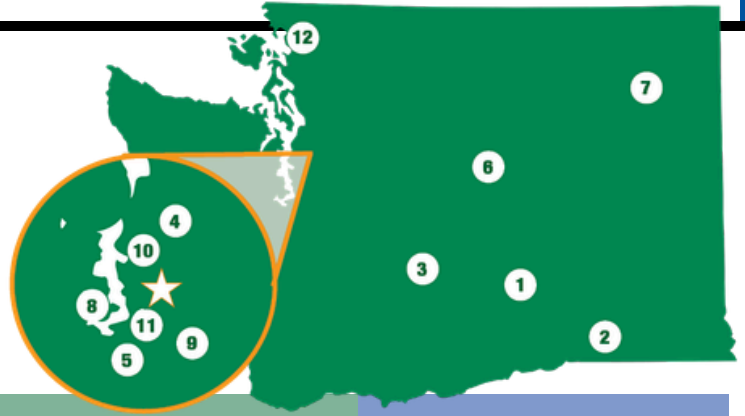

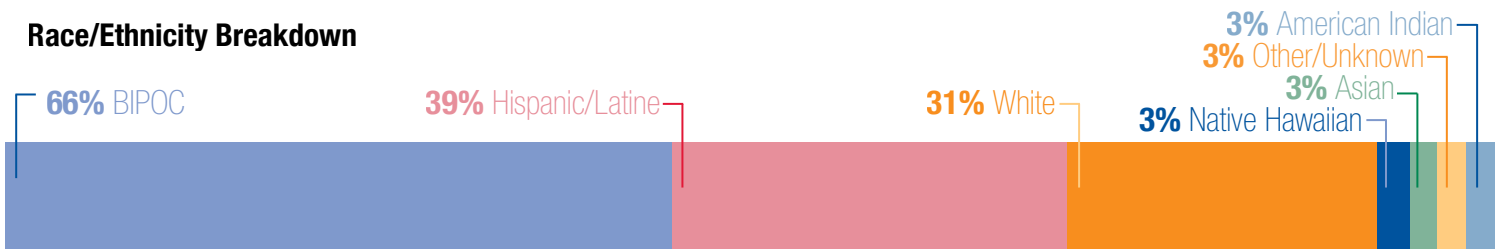
