**Reading Tutor:** work one-on-one or in small groups with students who are struggling with reading. Volunteers will be partnered with students and together, they will work through the All Star Readers program which is designed to help struggling readers meet their grade level in reading.

**Math Tutor:** work one-on-one or in small groups with students who are struggling with math and assist them with homework problems and questions.

**Tutor/Mentor:** work one-on-one with a student as their tutor/mentor at Mount Tahoma high school to help them stay on track to graduate on time and succeed in life. Become a caring adult in the life of a high school student that may be falling behind in school or struggling with living situations.

**Possible Selves:** share your career with students who are enrolled in the Possible Selves program at Baker middle school and Foss high school. This program is designed to help students start to plan for college and careers. Participants learn how to determine and set goals, research different career tracks, and learn how to be successful. Guest speakers are needed to share their life experiences and careers.

**Clothing Closet Supervisor:** supervise the "clothing closet" at Oakland High School. Many students at Oakland struggle to acquire even the basic resources, like clothing. The "clothing closet" is there to allow students who cannot afford clothing to pick out outfits, shoes, and other basic resources.

**Male Basketball Volunteer:** join students in a fun game of basketball. A plus if you know some techniques and drills!

**READY! Set, Read-Tacoma! Volunteer:** facilitate story time at an elementary school library or community site (community center, child care center, museum, etc.) for preschool-aged children and their families. Assist with art activities after story time.
