What is Stuff the Bus Campaign?

Stuff the Bus Campaign is a joint effort among Communities in Schools of Tacoma, United Way of Pierce County, KBTC and Tacoma Public Schools to provide children in need with backpacks, school supplies, clothing and shoes for the upcoming school year. Our goal this year is to provide these items to 4,000 children.

How Does it Work?

A school bus will drive to your work place on Thursday, August 25, 2016 and pick up donations of school supplies. Items will be sorted and distributed to the schools that the students attend.

Why Should I Participate?

Too many of our children start the school year without clothing, shoes, schools supplies and other basic items. If education is the key to a better future, we must provide all students with the tools necessary to succeed in school and prepare for life.
